

# WHEELER BRANCH PARK RULES

1. Only canoes, kayaks or open hull john boats (without bilge, live wells or floors) allowed to launch or operate on Wheeler Branch Reservoir. All watercraft must have plugs pulled and be completely drained and dry of water prior to entering Wheeler Branch Park. No watercraft with a gas powered engine will be allowed on the Wheeler Branch Reservoir. Electric trolling motors are allowed.
2. No lifeguard on duty - swim at your own risk
3. The rock islands across the reservoir from the swimming area have been designated as a bird sanctuary and nesting area and are off limits to swimmers
4. No fishing within 200 feet of swimmers
5. Fisherman must comply with all Texas Parks and Wildlife regulations, including fishing and boating laws.
6. No alcohol
7. Keep all vehicles on roads
8. Keep all pets on leashes
9. Please leave all trash in trash receptacles
10. All park patrons must stay within park boundaries
11. No open fires allowed
12. No swimming at boat launch area

**Entrance Fees:** The following entrance fees shall be applicable to all Wheeler Branch Park guests. Adults must have a valid driver's license showing a Somervell county address to qualify for a county resident discount.
